

Order No. 02	15.01.2025	<p>Petitioner through counsel present. Petitioner has filed an application requesting explanation of the judgment issued in case titled Mst. Haibata Vs Chairman NADRA, registered under suit no 102/1 of 2024. He states that NADRA office is refusing to issue FRC owing to the lack of clarity on a point raised in the instant petition.</p> <p>In the suit, plaintiff had enlisted two deceased persons as plaintiffs through their next of kin/heirs. To be precise, Mst. Haibata, although deceased, is enlisted as plaintiff no 01, and her son, and deceased Mr. Siyal Khan as plaintiff no 05.</p> <p>Impleading deceased persons is not permitted by law, but since the principal issue before the court was the court names of the parents of plaintiff no 02-04, the court did not dwell upon the issue. Reportedly, this frugality of the court has led to a confusion.</p> <p>Therefore, for convenience of all concerned, the correct names of the parents of the live plaintiffs are declared as Mst. Haibata and Mr. Noor Muhammad Khan. Quarters concerned shall keep their current and future records in line with the judgment.
