RAHID AMEEN VS THE STATE

ORDER
06.01.2025

Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present. Mr. Khan Amir Bagti Advocate present. Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. The accused/petitioner namely, Rahid Ameen s/o Zameen Khan r/o Sumari Banda, District Kohat is seeking his post arrest bail in case FIR No. 33, Dated 23.12.2024, U/S 9 (c) CNSA, registered at Police Station Ghiljo.

3. Facts of the case are that complainant Muhammad Imtiaz SHO PS Ghiljo sent a Murasila through constable Muhammad Tayyab no. 2164, that he along with other police officials were present on Nakabandi, during gasht of the area. In the meanwhile, a pedestrian coming from Ghiljo side was stopped due to suspicion, who was having green plastic shopper in his left hand, which was checked and 890 grams Chars were recovered from the same. The accused disclosed his name as Rahid Ameen s/o Zameen Shah. Video of the occurrence was prepared and 10 grams out of the total recovered Chars was separated for sending to

FSL for chemical analysis. The accused was arrested and hence, the instant FIR.

4. Arguments heard and available record perused which shows that the occurrence has taken place near Karapha check post 02/03 km from the police station. The site plan shows that the place of occurrence is main Ghiljo to Shaho road, which is a straight road and the accused being pedestrian could have easily avoid the police barricade, which is visible from quite a considerable distance and still crossing them while having contraband Chars in his possession is against the natural conduct of a person, furthermore, no FSL report is yet received to show that whether the recovered contraband is Chars or otherwise, which makes the case of accused/petitioner one of further inquiry, therefore, I hereby accept the instant bail petition subject to submission of bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 80,000/- with two sureties each, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.

5. Copy of this order be placed on police/judicial file. Case file be consigned to the record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
