Dy.PP for the state present. Complainant Hamid Khan present. Counsel for accused/petitioners present. Record received. Complainant stated that he has patched up the matter with accused/petitioners.

Statement of complainant Hamid Khan recorded wherein, he stated that he has got no objection on release of accused/petitioners on bail on the bases of compromise or subsequent acquittal of accused. Statement of complainant separately recorded which is duly thumb impressed by him. Compromise deed is Ex.PA. Copy of CNIC of Zahid Anwar (verifier) is Ex.PB.

Arguments heard and record perused.

Accused/petitioner namely case FIR No. 119 dated: 19.12.2024 U/S 506, 429 /34 PPC registered at Police Station Kalaya District Orakzai.

Complainant has patched up the matter with accused/petitioners and he has got no objection on release of accused/petitioners or on MASOOD UAZ MARSOOD their subsequent acquittal. The compromise seems genuine being Senior Civil Judge, their subsequent acquittal. The compromise seems genuine being without force and coercion. On merits, offence u/s 506 PPC with

which accused/petitioners are charged does not fall within the ambit

of prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.PC. In such like cases grant of bail is a rule and refusal is an exception. No extra ordinary circumstances are available on record for refusing bail of accused/petitioners.

Consequently, application in hand is allowed on the sole ground of compromise. Petitioners be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 70,000/- (Seventy thousand) with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. Copy of this order be placed on police as well as judicial record. The record be returned back to IO, while file of this court be consigned to record room after necessary completion and compilation.
