At the very outset, the representative of the (4). complainant stated at the bar that he has got no objection bail upon confirmation pre-arrest accused/petitioner. The accused is senior citizen and according to his CNIC his age is more than 64 years. Therefore, in the light of above, the already granted ad-interim pre-arrest bail of the accused/petitioner Lal Muhammad stands confirmed on 🖰 the strength of existing bail bonds.
