Petitioner through counsel present. Ex-parte arguments heard and record gone through.

Perusal of case file reveals that the instant petition is instituted by the petitioner namely **Mst. Sabira Jan Wd/O Minadar Khan** for her appointment as legal guardian for the persons of the minors namely **Mst. Gul Shana** (*DOB: 06.05.2007*), **Muhammad Hussain** (DOB: 01.01.2010) and **Waseem Hassan** (*DOB: 04.05.2011*) mentioned in the petition on the grounds that the petitioner is the real mother of the minors and that father of minors has been died on 20.05.2024.

The respondents/general public were summoned through publication in newspaper "Daily Ausaf" dated: 05.01.2025, however none turned up as legal guardian of the minors other than the petitioner. Therefore, the respondents were proceeded against ex-parte. Consequently, petitioner produced ex-parte evidence.

During course of recording evidence, Zulfiqar Ali (special attorney) appeared and recorded his statement as PW-01. Razib Ali and Izaz Ahmad Servor Civil Judge Orderai at Baber Mela deposed as PW-02 & PW-03 respectively. PW-01 produced his power of 3 1 JAN 2025 attorney as Ex.PW-1/1, copy of his CNIC as Ex.PW-1/2, copy of death certificate of father of minors as Ex.PW-1/3, form "B" of minors as Ex.PW-1/4, FRC consists of 02 pages as Ex.PW-1/5, copy of CNIC of mother of minors as Ex.PW-1/6. Copies of CNICs of PW-02 and PW-03 are Ex.PW-2/1 and Ex.PW-3/1. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.

At this stage there seems to be no clash of interest between the minors and the petitioner, being the real mother of the minors, in the light of statements of witnesses produced by the petitioner, it is evident that minors are residing presently with the petitioner, who is looking after them. As a real mother, she is most likely to take care of the welfare of the minors. Therefore, the petition in hand is accepted under Section-07 of Guardian & Wards Act, 1890 and petitioner is appointed as guardian of the person of the minors namely **Mst. Gul Shana** (*DOB: 06.05.2007*), **Muhammad Hussain** (DOB: 01.01.2010) and **Waseem Hassan** (*DOB: 04.05.2011*) having generally the rights, duties and liabilities of a guardian mentioned in the Guardian & Wards Act, 1890 and subject to the following conditions especially in view of section-34 of the said Act.

- That she will produce the minors in court as and when required by the court.
- That she will maintain and educate the minors in proper manner.
- That she will not act in prejudice to the interest of minors.
- That she will not be entitled to dispose of the property of minors

without prior permission of the court.
