


Order No.02	08.02.2025	<p>Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the state present. PW Mohsin Ali IO present and examined as PW-1. Prosecution abandoned the remaining PWs and closed its evidence.</p> <p>The prosecution's as unfolded in the First Information Report (FIR) is as follows: After receipt of information regarding drugs smuggling, the complainant, Altaf Ali SHO along with other police personnel, set up a picket on main route that connects Kurez to Dawalye on 14.10.2024 where at about 07:30 hours a person with a bag on his shoulder, was called to stop by the police but he left the bag and managed to get away. The complainant found 15 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams and wrapped in yellow scotch tape, totaling 15,000 grams, inside the bag. For chemical analysis using FSL, the complainant separated 10 grams of chars from each packet and sealed them into parcels no. 1 to 15. The remaining quantity of chars weighing 14,850 grams and the bag were sealed in parcel no. 16. The spot proceedings were recorded using a cell phone and stored on a USB that was packed in parcel no. 17. All parcels were placed/affixed with a monogram of 'AA'. The complainant took into possession the recovered chars vide recovery memo. Murasila was drafted and sent to Police Station through constable Rahim Ali for registration of FIR which was converted into FIR by Moharrir Ibad Ul Hassan.</p> <p>After registration of FIR, it was handed over to Investigation Officer for investigation. Accordingly, after receipt of FIR, he reached the spot, prepared site plan Ex. PB on pointation of the complainant and recorded the statements of PWs u/s 161 Cr.P.C. On 17.10.2024, the IO sent the samples of chars for chemical analysis to FSL; the result whereof was received and placed on file by him. The IO could not find any clue about the accused and failed to arrest the accused being unknown; therefore, the prosecution submitted challan against an unknown accused. The investigation officer was summoned and examined as PW-1.</p> <p>Perusal of the case file reveals that despite the investigation conducted by the IO/PW-1, he could not find any clue about the accused; therefore, this would serve no purpose to carry on further proceedings in the instant case. Hence, the request of prosecution is conceded and case is directed to be filed being untraced subject to condition that the local police may reopen the case file as and when any clue about the accused involved in the commission of offence is found. Case property be dealt with in accordance with law.
