drafted and sent to the police station through constable Syed Hassan Raza for registration of FIR which was converted into FIR by Muharrir Ibad ul Hassan.

After registration of FIR, it was handed over to Investigation Officer for investigation. Accordingly, after receipt of FIR, he reached the spot, prepared site plan, Ex.PB, on the pointation of the complainant and recorded the statements of PWs u/s 161 Cr.PC. The IO sent the samples of chars for chemical analysis to FSL the result whereof was received and placed on file by him. The IO could not found any clue about the accused and failed to arrest the accused being unknown; therefore, he has submitted the challan against unknown accused. The prosecution submitted an untraced challan against unknown accused to file the same; therefore, investigation officer was summoned, who appeared and his statement recorded on 08.02.2025.

Perusal of the case file reveals that despite the investigation conducted by the IO, he could not find any clue about the accused, therefore, this would serve no purpose to carry one further proceedings in the instant case, hence, the request of prosecution is conceded and case is directed to be filed being untraced subject to condition that the local police may reopen the case file as and when any clue about the accused involved in the commission of offence is found. The case property be dealt with in accordance with law.
